**Sculpture at Sawmillers** is the initiative Elsa Atkin, a long time resident of McMahons Point, and a small group of other residents who have been working together with the support of North Sydney Council to ensure that the exhibition does justice to the venue, and to the sculptors who have been chosen to exhibit. Over 120 sculptors submitted their work and 67 have been chosen by the Selection Panel, Michael Snape (sculptor), Nick Vickers (curator), and Jane Watters (gallery director). Exhibiting artists include established sculptors and emerging artists.

Sculpture at Sawmillers is a **free** event and open to the general public. It will be held from **17-25 September 2016** at the harbourside park, **Sawmillers Reserve, McMahons Point**. The exhibition will be launched by the **former Governor General of Australia, Dame Quentin Bryce, on Saturday 17 September at 3:30pm**.
